RE: WEEE European Union Directive 2002/96/EC
RoHS European Union Directive 2002/95/EC

The European Union (EU) has enacted two Directives, the first on product recycling (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment, WEEE) and the second limiting the use of certain substances (Restriction on the use of Hazardous Substances, RoHS). Over time, these Directives will be implemented in the national laws of each EU Member State.

WEEE

We have been labeling our products with the waste decal since August 15, 2005. We shall continue to incorporate the waste decal into our labels or by molding wherever possible.

RoHS

RoHS Category 8 and 9 products covered by the WEEE Directive are currently exempt from the RoHS Directive. Our products fall into Category 9 and are therefore exempt from the RoHS directive. Our original objective to comply with the RoHS directive has been delayed. Further information will be posted when available.

We will continue to monitor the application of the RoHS Directive to our products and will comply with any changes that may occur.
