

## Customer Tariff Charge Statement

We understand there has been recent news regarding legal challenges to certain U.S. import tariffs. While court decisions are an important part of that process, **these additional tariffs remain in effect and are still being assessed on our imports by U.S. Customs and Border Protection at this time.**

As a result, our company **continues to incur these additional tariff costs directly** when manufacturing and importing affected materials and components from international suppliers. Until we receive official confirmation from the appropriate government authorities that the tariffs have been reduced, suspended, or refunded — and we see those changes reflected in actual import charges — **we must continue to pass through the applicable tariff costs as part of our pricing.**

If and when the tariffs are formally lifted and our costs are adjusted accordingly, we will re-evaluate our pricing and make any appropriate changes at that time.
